

QUINCY 2021

Les Grandes Vignes de Villalin

Quincy is one of the 7 vineyards that make up the Centre Loire region. Its single grape variety, Sauvignon, is also the emblematic grape variety of the Centre Loire.

The vines are planted on ancient terraces of the Cher river. This sedimentary origin gives the wines a unique flavour in which Sauvignon finds its finest expression.



Soil

The "Grandes Vignes de Villalin "vineyard is situated on the right bank of the Cher. Its terroir is very mineral, with sedimentary origins and is composed of sandy gravel.

Grape variety

100% Sauvignon, vineyard planted in 1994

Area and production

0,30 ha or approximately 1800 bottles (45 hl/ha)

Winemaking

Harvested manually, the grapes are pressed, followed by 24 hours of settling. Fermentation (native yeasts) and aging in jars (500 liter stoneware) for 10 months. Then passed into vats a few months before bottling in winter 2022

Tasting notes

Smooth on the palate, gradually developing lemony notes. The ageing gives this cuvée its generous character.

Specifications

Aging in jars produces chiseled, fresh, fruity wines. It also adds depth and roundness to this cuvée, while retaining its minerality and finesse. This method of ageing also gives it exceptional cellaring potential.

This cuvée needs 2 to 3 years before it opens up fully. Don't hesitate to decant before tasting.
